What?

We will gather at the Senate Square on Saturday 11th September at 13:00. The march begins by walking via Aleksanterinkatu and Mannerheimintie to the Parliament House, where Päivi Räsänen, Member of Parliament, will give a speech. There will also be musical performances. The event is expected to end at the latest 16.00.
